Dry Ice Safety and Information Sheet

Please follow the precautions below if you handle, transport or use dry ice for any reason

DRY ICE (CO₂)

SOLIDIFIED CARBON DIOXIDE

WARNING

EXTREME COLD

- The temperature of dry ice is -109.3°F (-78.5°C)
- Sever cold burns will occur within seconds of direct contact
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes
- Do not eat or taste dry ice!

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DO NOT SEAL IN GLASS OR OTHER TIGHTLY CLOSED CONTAINERS

- This could result in busting or exploding from over pressurization

ASPHYXIAN

- Liberates CO₂ vapor that is heavier than air
- CO₂ vapor tends to migrate to lower elevations and to accumulate in confined areas. CO₂ vapors must be removed at the floor level of rooms or other enclosures to prevent dangerous accumulations
- Do not enter areas where dry ice is used or stored until properly ventilated

USE OF PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Heavy gloves, safety shoes, safety glasses, hard hat and protective clothing should be used when handling dry ice

CARRIERS MUST BE NOTIFIED

- If you are shipping dry ice products, you must notify the carrier and affix a warning label(s) before shipping.
