

# Dry Ice Safety and Information Sheet

Please follow the precautions below if you handle, transport or use dry ice for any reason



# **EXTREME COLD**

- The temperature of dry ice is -109.3°F (-78.5°C)
- Sever cold burns will occur within seconds of direct contact
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes
- Do not eat or taste dry ice!

# **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

# DO NOT SEAL IN GLASS OR OTHER TIGHTLY CLOSED CONTAINERS

This could result in busting or exploding from over pressurization

## **ASPHYXIANT**

- Liberates CO2 vapor that is heavier than air
- CO2 vapor tends to migrate to lower elevations and to accumulate in confined areas. CO2 vapors must be removed at the floor level of rooms or other enclosures to prevent dangerous accumulations
- Do not enter areas where dry ice is used or stored until properly ventilated

## **USE OF PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

Heavy gloves, safety shoes, safety glasses, hard hat and protective clothing should be used when handling dry ice

## **CARRIERS MUST BE NOTIFIED**

If you are shipping dry ice products, you must notify the carrier and affix a warning label(s) before shipping.
